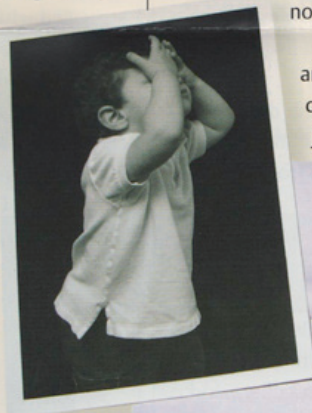


Kathy Boston shows her Care Cards display at the Discovery Exchange Bookstore.

Kathy Boston discovered a void in the greeting card industry several years ago, and the registered nurse and 1983 Columbus State graduate immediately set out to fill it.

Kathy's Care Cards are for people suffering from cancer, pain, disease and life-altering events. Boston founded her company after unsuccessful attempts to find cards that said the right things for friends and patients with cancer.

Boston, a nurse for 25 years, was used to multitasking. She attended college at night while the youngest of her three kids was still in diapers. As a nurse, she understands the importance of knowing what to say to



someone dealing with illness. "The worst thing to say is nothing at all," says Boston.

Kathy's Care Cards are created using donated artwork, and the cards share a brief story about each artist. The cards, as well as a jewelry line called Kathy's Hope Jewelry, representing eight types of cancer, are carried

in Columbus State's bookstore and retail complex, Discovery Exchange. Columbus State was the first college bookstore to carry Kathy's care products, bringing the 1983 graduate full circle back to her alma mater.
